If you would like to contribute, please submit your abstract (max. 1800 characters including spaces) by July 18 through this form.

The abstract should briefly outline the topic, methodology, and results of your contribution. Submissions (and presentations) can be in either German or English, although the conference will primarily be conducted in German. Contributions can also include work of lesser scope (e.g., term papers) or work that is not yet complete.
